### **Tucker Horne Completes Eagle Scout Project**

Huntersville, N.C. - On July 12, Tucker Horne, the son of John and June and a member of Boy Scout Troop 19 completed his Eagle Scout Project. Tucker, with the help of many fellow scouts, family members and friends completed his project which consisted of making several drainage improvements to the farm property. The first order of business was to replace an undersized and short pipe under the main access road to the farm with a newer, larger diameter and longer pipe. During this phase of his project, Tucker was assisted greatly by Johnny Massingale and some heavy equipment from Ponders, Inc.

Next, Tucker and his crew improved the inlet and outlet sides of the new pipe with decorative river stone and small boulders. Lastly, they created a small berm and channel to keep excess water from washing over another nearby road on the property. Tucker's project took approximately 125 man-hours to complete.
