Luke Savage Completes Eagle Scout Project

Huntersville, N.C. - On June 5, Luke Savage, the eldest son of Jonathon and Lynn Savage and a member of Boy Scout Troop 13 completed his Eagle Scout Project. Luke, with the help of many fellow scouts, family members and friends completed the construction of a handicapped accessible mounting ramp. The ramp will be used to support the therapeutic riding aspect of the program(s) at Hinds Feet Farm.

The more than 44 foot long ramp, complete with two landings to be used for mounting/dismounting horses with the assistance of trained volunteers, was made of pressure-treated pine and took more than 400 man-hours to construct.

The ramp will eventually be placed in the to-be-constructed riding arena, adjacent to the new barn.
