Huntersville, N.C. - On an overcast January day, Nathan Schulte, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Dan Schulte and a member of Boy Scout Troop 13 completed his Eagle Scout Project. Nathan, with the help of fellow scouts, family members and friends completed his project which consisted of installing low voltage lighting along the pathway leading up to the multi-purpose building.

For his project, Nathan installed 21 low voltage fixtures mounted on rough hewn cedar posts. The path lights are set up on a timer, controlling when the lights are turned on and off. The new path lights will enable clients and guests to use the multi-purpose building after sunset and walk safely to their cars or the residence.

Nathan's project took over 144 man-hours to complete.
